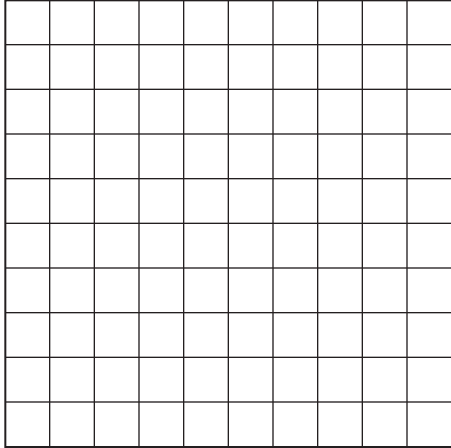
- Describe a positive test for sugar with Benedict's solution.
