1a.	Fruit is a woody cone	2
1b.	Fruit is not a woody cone	3
2a.	Cone is smaller that 1"	Eastern Hemlock
2b.	Cone is 1.5" or longer	Scotch Pine
3a.	Fruit is a nut or is round.	4
3b.	Fruit is not a nut or round	5
4a.	Seed is dark and large with many rough grooves and ridges	Black Walnut
4b.	Seed is not large and has no rough grooves or ridges	6
5a.	Fruit is flat or wing-shaped, not pod-shaped	8
5b.	Fruit is a pod-shaped	9
6a.	Seed is less than ½"	Little Leaf Linden
6b.	Seed is larger than ½"	7
7a.	Seed is brown, surrounded by a dark, spiny or warty capsule	Horse Chestnut
7b.	Seed is pale, 1" to 1 ¼"	Shagbark Hickory
8a.	Fruit is flat and circular or oval in shape	Siberian Elm
8b.	Fruit is not circular or oval in shape	10
9a.	Pod is over 5" in length, dark brown, hairy, curved ant twisted	Honey Locust
9b.	Pod is 2 ½" to 3 ½", flat oblong pointed at ends	Redbud
10a.	Fruit is long, flat and slender, not a true wing shape	Green Ash
10b.	Fruit is wing shaped	11
11a.	Fruit has dark brown solid wing, 1–2"	Norway Maple
11b.	Fruit has feathery wing and is light in color, 1.5–3"	Silver Maple
